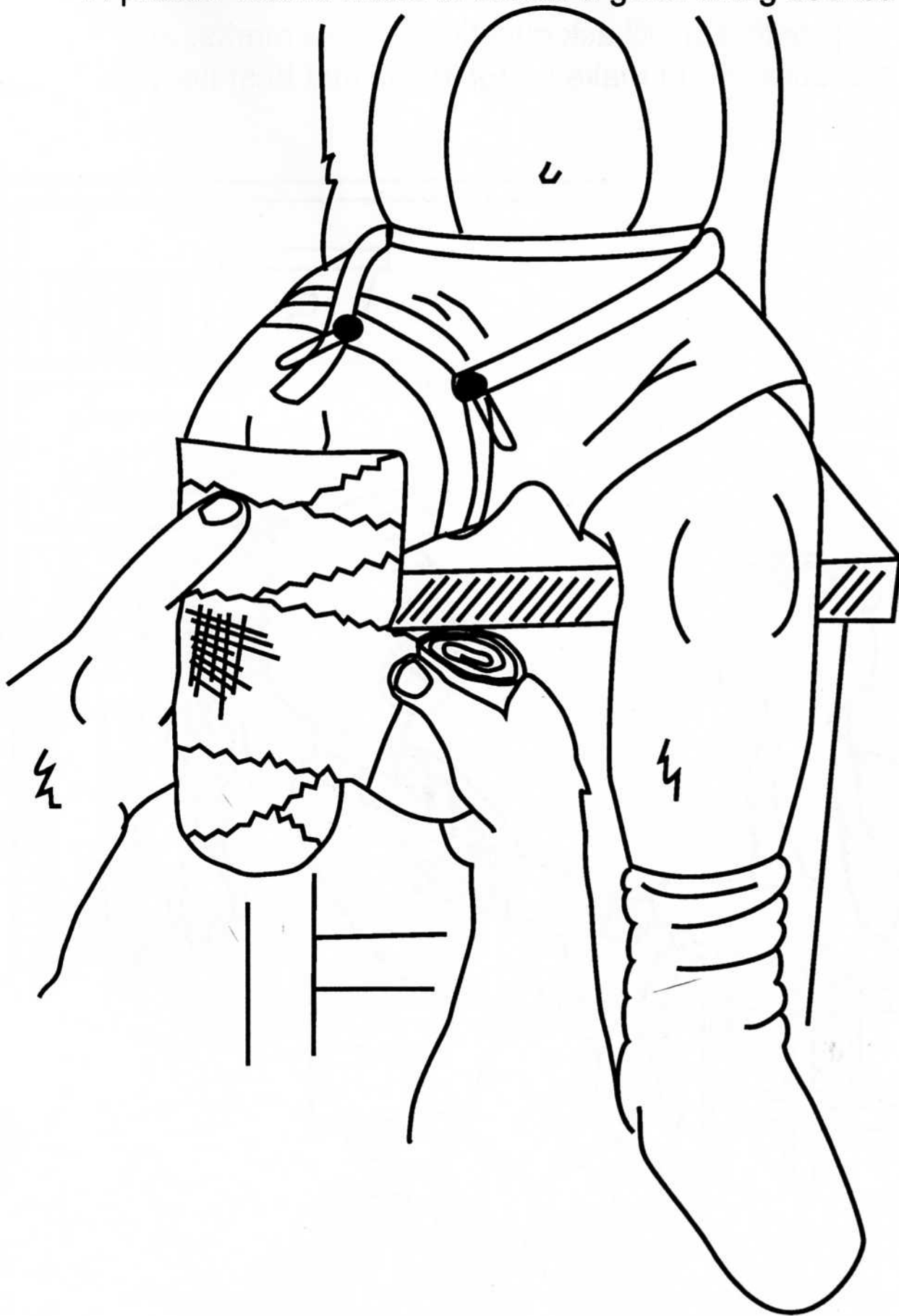
A prosthetist (pras'-the-tist) has special skills and tools to make artificial limbs called prostheses (pras-the'-ses).

A plaster cast is made to create a good fitting socket.

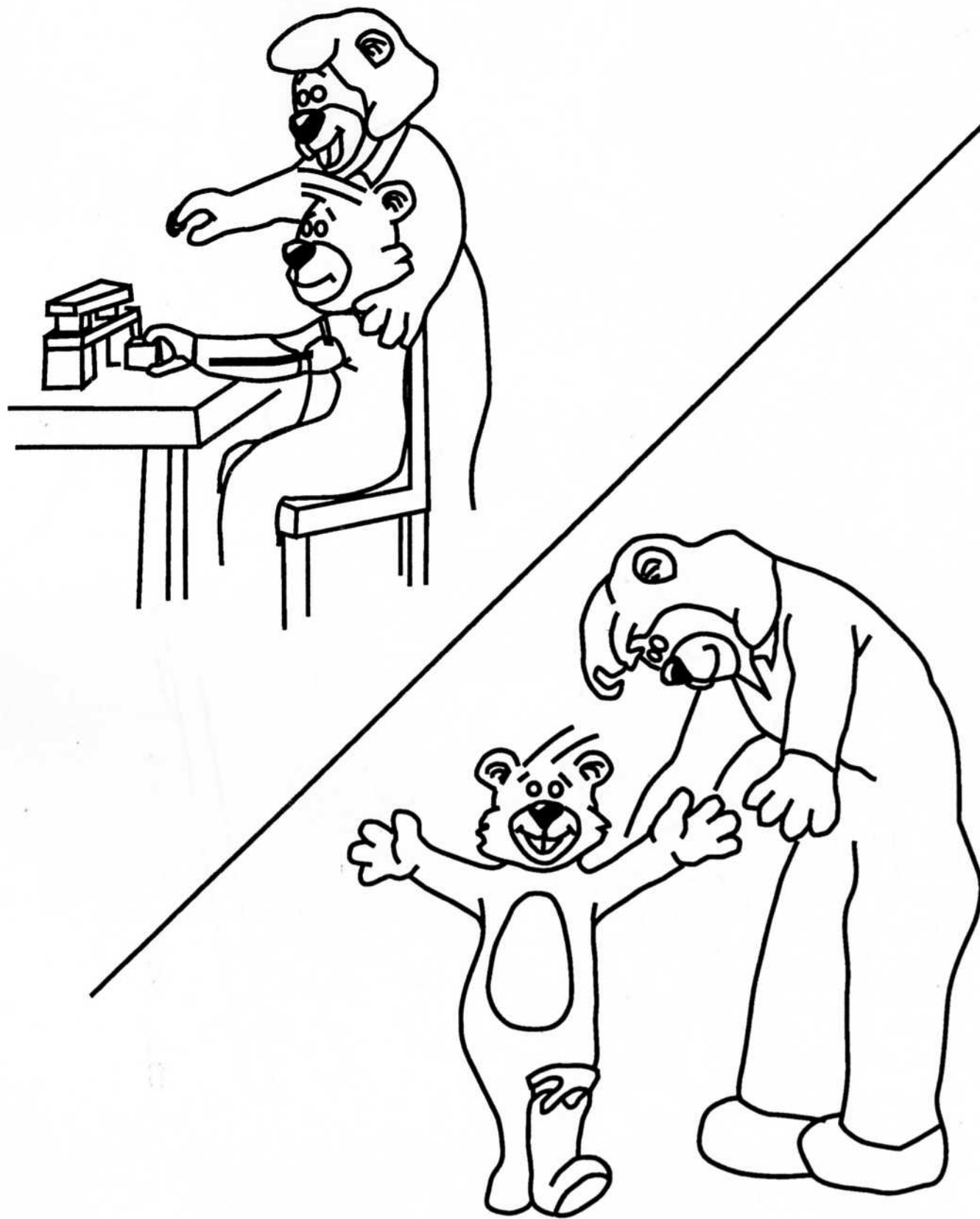


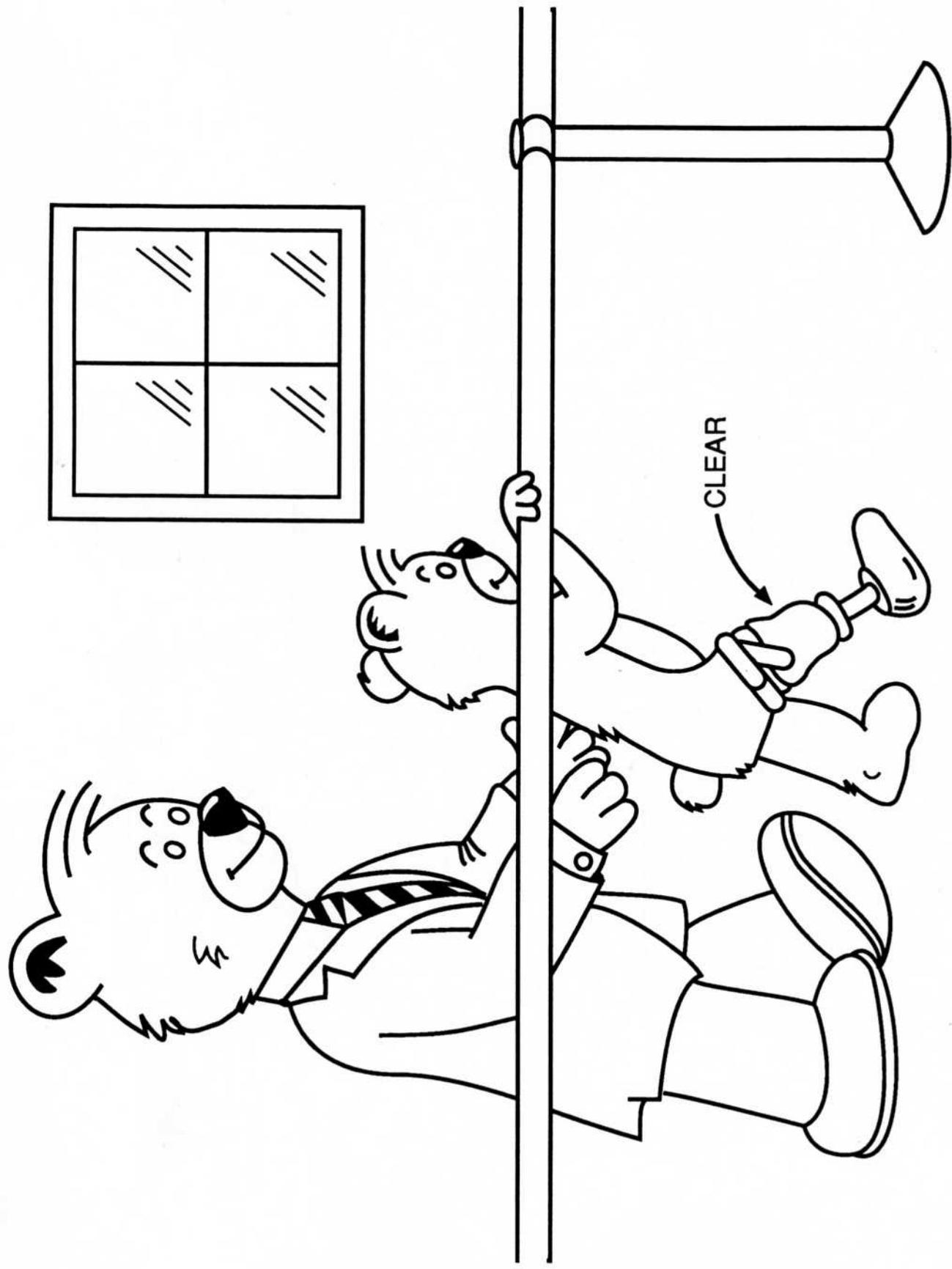


The doctor helps you stay healthy and happy.
